Graham Tebb was educated at Oxford University and the EMBL in Heidelberg before working as a post-doc at the IMP in Vienna. After a brief spell as an Editor at *Nature* and a longer one at the United Nations, he spent over a decade as a scientific administrator in the Department of Biology and Medicine at the FWF before joining the Office for Research Funding and Innovation at the Vetmeduni in Vienna.

Since May 2024 he has also been working part-time in the Office for Research Support at the MUI, advising scientists and clinicians on how apply for third-party funding and helping them polish their manuscripts for publication. He gives regular courses on scientific writing, interview skills, scientific presentations and writing applications for third-party funding.
