Standortagentur Tirol - k-REGIO Call 2020

The new k-Regio call has been published November 5th, 2020. k-Regio is by far the biggest funding scheme published by Land Tyrol. Consortia consisting at least of three partners - at least two of them from industry and one from academia - are eligible to apply for a project with a duration of three years and a total funding of max. 300.000,- p/a (900.000,- per project). The funding rate for each participating organization depends on their legal status.

For the first time the call is thematically restricted. Two thematic areas are addressed:

- Green, environment and climate

- Health and digitalization

New call "European Green Deal" also contains health-related topics

On September 22nd, the European Commission published one of the last Horizon 2020 calls for the "European Green Deal". The call encompasses ten areas, including one with health relevance: "Zeropollution, toxic free environment", which has two topics published:

- Innovative, systemic zero-pollution solutions to protect health, environment and natural resources from persistent and mobile chemicals (LC-GD-8-1-2020)
- Fostering regulatory science to address combined exposures to industrial chemicals and pharmaceuticals: from science to evidence-based policies (LC-GD-8-2-2020)

The deadline for submission is January 26, 2021.

Draft workprogrammes for Horizon Europe available

Officially, Horizon Europe starts at January 1st, 2021 and also is planned for seven years but dur to the Covid-19 pandemic and several other unforseen delays in adopting the new Multiannual Financial Framework (MFF) the first calls for proposals can be ecpected during the first quarter of 2021. The very first calls for proposals presumably will be related to the ERC (European Research Council) supprogramme of Hozrizon Europe.

The Department "Research Services and Innovation" managed in the meantime to organize recent drafts of the workprogrammes for most of the first calls of the new programme as well as other supporting documents. Unfortunately these workprogrammes and most of the documents are confidential so that we are not allowed to spread them publicly on our webpages or by mass emails. But on request of our researchers I can send them to you personally.

If you are interested in specific workprogrammes please do not hesitate to get in contact with me and so that I can provide you with the specific informations. As a short overview, you can find the structure of the new fundig programme under this address: https://ec.europa.eu/info/horizon-europe_en Additionally we have been invited to join a new national initiative to take part in the discussion about as well as influence of the content of the new programme: the so-called "Horizon Europe Community Platforms".
