doc.funds Programme – 3rd Call for applications

doc.funds is a programme to promote outstanding doctoral programmes and to consolidate existing education and training structures for highly qualified junior researchers. Applicants can request additional funding for any structured doctoral programme that has been in existence for at least two years. The university (or universities) offering the programme must be clearly committed to providing basic funding, that is, providing all of the necessary infrastructure as well as funds for the on-going operation and institutional anchoring of the programme.

i-med Research Scholarships for graduated young scientists

In 2019, the Medical University of Innsbruck offers again research scholarships for graduated young scientists.

This is a bridge funding for graduates of the Medical University of Innsbruck, who have the prospect of a position in a third party funded research project (eg FWF, ÖNB, EU) or for bridging between two funding projects. Furthermore, the scholarship can be used to carry out final work in a third-party funded research project.

For students in doctoral colleges a special justification is necessary, why an extension beyond the already financed time is necessary.

The subsidies correspond to the current rates of the regulation for travel expenses (Reisegebührevorschrift, group 2a, only day-fees, no travel costs).

MUI-START Programme-10th Call

The 10th MUI-START Call will be open from 1st February 2019 until 31st March 2019.

Objective: The programme has been devised to give young scientists the opportunity of developing new project ideas that could serve as basis for a subsequent application for third-party funding (e. g. FWF, ÖenB).

What is new in this call?

- Increased budget (max. 80.000,00 € per project for max. 24 months).
- Personnel costs for student assistants and/or technical staff are allowed.
- Possibility of submitting not only stand-alone projects but also larger cooperative interdisciplinary or multidisciplinary research projects.
