New Call – R&D Infrastructure FFG 2nd Call

Target group: all researchers

Deadline: 11 July 2017

On 28th of March, FFG published its second call for funding of Research & Development Infrastructures. Within this funding scheme both research organisations and private companies can apply for projects with maximum project size is 1,5 M€ (purchase of durable equipment and personnel costs for setting up the infrastructure).

Similar to the first call there will be two possible project types, one for economically exploited infrastructures and one for infrastructures used for science and education. Applicants are encouraged to form a consortium with focus on the shared use of the infrastructures funded. As there are only two projects eligible per organization as lead partner, the Medical University Innsbruck will start an internal pre-selection process to choose the two most promising projects which then will be invited to apply for the grants next week.
