New Call: JRC - Expression of Interest for Collaborative Doctoral Partnerships in the thematic field of Genomics and bioinformatics

The European Joint Research Centre (JRC) is starting a new initiative to implement so-called „Collaborative Doctoral Partnerships“ (CDP) with higher education institutions from Member States and countries associated to Horizon 2020. The aim is to co-develop, co-host and co-supervise doctoral studies together with the JRC in order to raise the excellence by incorporating a science-policy interface dimension into doctoral studies.

CDP does not involve any exchange of money, costs are shared according to the stay at JRC and the participating institution. During the stay at JRC (between one and three years) JRC will cover the costs of the doctoral student including salary, necessary training and work-related travels.

Deadline for applying the Expression of Interests is March 15th, 2017.

After the selection of the institutions, separate collaboration agreements will be signed. These are envisaged to have an initial duration of 5 years.

Funding of Open Access Publications at the MUI

The Medical University of Innsbruck financially supports its researchers when publishing in Open Access Journals through a newly established publication fund.

Supported are publication costs (Article Processing Charges - APCs) up to a maximum of 2,000 Euros for open access publications under the following conditions:

- The article appears in a "pure" Open Access journal (listed in [DOAJ](#)) and is freely accessible to the public via the Internet.

- The journal must be ranked in the [Journal Citation Reports](#) in the relevant discipline in the upper 25%.
- Only new applications will be funded.
- The publication must be accepted by the publisher at the time of the application.
- Submitting "or" corresponding author "is a member of the MUI and responsible for the payment of the publication costs.
- Affiliation address is Medizinische Universität Innsbruck or Medical University Innsbruck.
- The journal must be listed in the [DOAJ](#) and meet the quality criteria defined there or the Open Access Journal has a quality assurance procedure (peer review).
- The article must appear under a [Creative Commons license](#).

No funding,

- if publication costs are taken over from other sponsors such as FWF, EU, etc.
- for buying free hybrid open access publications in subscription journals.

Applications can be submitted to the Service Center Research. If the invoice has already been paid, a compensation of up to € 2,000 will be paid. Open bills up to € 2,000, - can also be paid directly to the publisher via the publication fund.

The funding works on "first come - first served" basis. There is no legal claim to this promotion. If the financial resources of the publication fund of the Medical University of Innsbruck are exhausted, no further funding is possible.
